

# WATERCOLOR FLOWERS: YELLOW EGG



## MATERIALS

C80370 Eggs Medium Brush Small Brush Liner Brush Pencil or Water-Based Marker

### COLORS

CMM 18- Pumpkin Pie CMM 47 - Deep Sea CMM 19 - Banana Boat CMM 92 - Ghostly Grape CMM 29 - Grasshopper

### INSTRUCTIONS

This piece can be made with any combination of colors. Below are the instructions for how this exact piece was made, but make it your own to fit your needs!

- 1. Water down some Banana Boat paint by mixing 50% water with 50% paint.
- 2. Use a medium brush to apply one coat all over the egg. Move the brush in an x-motion to help achieve the watercolor look.
- 3. Thin down the Ghostly Grape, Grasshopper, and Deep Sea with 75% paint to 25% water.
- 4. Use a detail brush to apply the simple 5-petal flowers, alternating between the blue and the purple.
- 5. Use a liner brush to apply the stems by starting at the base of the flower and pulling down to the base of the egg.
- 6. Then, to apply the grass, start with the liner brush at the base of the egg and flick upward to create the grass.
- 7. Dip the handle of the detail brush into Pumpkin Pie paint and tap 3 dots to the center of each flower.

## TIPS

- By watering the paint down, you'll achieve a more translucent, watercolor effect. Do not worry about 3 coats, we are not going for solid colors.
- If desired, you can sketch on the flowers before painting them.
